1998	Composed theme and score to HBO's "Sex and the City".
2002	Composed theme and incidental music for PBS's "Now with Bill Moyers".
2004	"You Are Only An Instrument" debuts at The Joyce Theatre in New York City.
2007	"Kyrie" premieres with Chanticleer, recorded on the album "And On Earth, Peace: A Chanticleer Mass".
2008	"Arjuna's Dilemma" premieres at Brooklyn Academy of Music's Next Wave Festival. "Fortune", for children's chorus and soloist, debuts with Young People's Chorus of New York. "Only Breath", for solo cello and electronics, debuts with Maya Beiser and is toured on her program "Provenance".
2009	"A Far Playground", for viola or cello and piano, premieres at New York City's Merkin Concert Hall.
